Classic Lace Wrap

Materials List:

Yarn

1 skein Sensations™ Cuddle (70% acrylic,30% nylon, 3.5oz/100g, 404 yd/370mm) 3/Light, color #49910 Brown

Hooks & Notions Gauge Measurements US H-8 (5mm) $5 \text{ sc} = 1^{\circ} (2.5 \text{ cm})$ 65" x 18"

(162.5cm x 45cm)

Tapestry Needle

Solomon's Knot (SK): Draw loop on hook about 3/8", yo, pull through, insert hook between single and double loops, yo, pull through, yo, pull through 2 loops on hook (single Solomon's Knot made).



Double Treble: Wrap yarn around hook 3 times, insert hook into st, yo, pull through adding loop on hook, (yo, pull through 2 loops on hook) 4 times.

Ch 270

NOTE: Patterns requires 4 + 2, to increase or decrease add or subtract 4 ch in foundation ch.

Row 1 (RS): Working in blo, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across. Turn. (269 sc)

Row 2 (WS): Ch 1, sc in each sc across. Turn.

Row 3: Repeat Row 2.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in 1st sc, *2 SK, sk 3 sc, sc in next st; repeat * across. Turn.

Row 5: Ch 5, SK, *sl st in next sc, 2 SK, sk sc, sl st in next sc; repeat * across, ending with SK, DT in last sc of previous row. Turn.

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in 1st sc, *ch 3, sk sc, sc in next sc; repeat * across, ending with sc in top of ch-5.

Row 7: Ch 1, *sc in next sc, (sc in next ch) 3 times; repeat * across, ending with sc in top of ch-5. Turn.

Row 8: Ch 4, sk 1 sc, dc in next sc, *ch 1, sk 1 sc, dc in next sc; repeat * across, ending with dc in last sc. Turn.

Row 9: Ch 2, * hdc in ch-1, hdc in dc; repeat * across, ending with hdc in 3^{rd} ch of ch-4 . Turn. Copyright © 2015 by Tanis Galik, all rights reserved.

Row 10: Ch 2, working in blo, hdc in each hdc, leaving a ch design on RS. Turn.

Row 11: Ch 1, working in flo, sc in each hdc, leaving a ch design on RS. Turn.

Row 12: Ch 4, sk1 sc, dc in next sc, *ch 1, sk 1 sc, dc in next sc. Turn.

Row 13: Ch 1,*sc in dc, sc in next ch; repeat * across, ending with sc in 3rd ch of ch-4.

Rows 14 -19: Repeat Rows 4-9.

Row 20: Ch 2, working in flo, hdc in each hdc, leaving a ch design on RS. Turn.

Row 21: Ch 1, working in blo, sc in each hdc, leaving a ch design on RS. Turn.

Row 22 -23: Repeat Rows 12 & 13.

Repeat Rows 4-23 until measures 17" or desired width, ending with Row 7.

Finishing Rows

Rows 1 - 3: Repeat Row 2.

Edging with RS facing

Rnd 1; Sc in each st around with 3 sc in each corner.

Rnd 2: Working in blo, sl st along length, sc along short ends, with 3 sc in each corner. Fasten off and weave in ends.
