## **Doggie Biscuit Toy**

Materials List:

Yarn

Acrylic or Cotton Yarn - Brown (A), Tan (B) Small – 5.5" x 3" (at bone) A-18.5 yds/B-11.25 yds Medium – 7.25" x 4.5" A-27 yds/B-17 yds Large – 11" x 6" A-37 yds/B- 22.5 yds

Hooks & Notions Gauge

4 sc = 1" (2.5cm) US H-8 (5mm)

Tapestry Needle

Note: Biscuit worked on right side only. Do not turn.



## Make 2

Rnd 1:With A, ch 13 (20, 26), sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, sc in each ch across foundation chain (11, 18, 24), sc in end chain. Work sc across other side of foundation chain, 3 sc in end.

Rnd 2: Work in blo, \*10 dc in next sc, sk sc, sc in next 8 sc (15, 21), sk sc, 10 dc in next sc, sc in end sc; repeat \* around.

Rnd 3: Work in blo, sl st around entire bone. Join with sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> sl st, fasten off A.

Rnd 4: Join B in end sl st, working in blo, \*hdc in end st, hdc in each dc, sl st along bone edge, hdc in each dc; repeat \* around, ending with sl st in 1st hdc. Fasten off first biscuit. Do not fasten off second biscuit.

## Unite Both Biscuits

With WS together, continue working B and sc around edge working through back loop of front biscuit and front loop of back biscuit. Join with sl st into first sc, fasten off and weave in ends.
