Ruby Romance Evening Clutch/Purse

Materials List:

Yarn

1 ball Premier Deborah Norville Collection – Everyday Soft Worsted (100% acrylic, 4oz [113g], 203yd [186m]) in color Really Red (A)

1 ball Plymouth Yarn Eros II (100% nylon, 50g, 165yd) in color 3003 315 (B)

Hooks & Notions Gauge Measurements US J-10 (6mm) $4 \text{ st} = 1^{\prime\prime} (2.5 \text{cm}) 10^{\prime\prime} \text{ x } 7^{\prime\prime}$ Crochet Marker (25.5cm x 18cm)

Needle Thread

Optional:

Black Lining Fabric Handle - Silver Necklace or Chain 8.5" (21.5cm) ¼" dowel of light wood Beautiful Pin or Other Decoration



Purse Base

With A ch 73, sc in next ch, sc in each ch across. Join with sl st to 1st ch. (Be careful not to twist foundation ch.) Mark beg with crochet marker.

Rnd 1: Sc in each sc around. (72 sc)

Rnd 2: Repeat Rnd 1.

Rnd3: Add B in front of A and work together, repeat Rnd 1.

Rnd 4: Drop A to back, with B hdc in each sc around.

Rnd 5: Pick up A behind B and work together, sc in each hdc around.

Repeat Rnds 4 and 5 until measures 6" (15.5cm).

Purse Flap

Row 1: With A & B work sc across 31 sc. Turn.

Row 2: Carry A along bottom and crochet over it with B, hdc in each sc across. Turn.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until flap measures 4" (10cm).

Row 3: Drop B, with A only sc in each st across. Turn.

Row 4: With A only sc in each st across.

Opening & Flap Edging

With A only, sc in each sc along flap edge, with 3 sc in corner sts. Add B when reach multi-yarn edge, sc in each sc around purse opening, join with sl st in 1st sc. End off. Weave in ends.

Bottom Seam

With RS together, sew or sc bottom seam. End off. Weave in end.

Blocking

If blocking is necessary, cold water block. Dampen purse, pin into shape and allow to dry completely. **Do Not Use Iron or Heat since yarn is nylon.**

For Clutch

Add Lining (if desired) and Decorative Pin

For Purse

When adding lining, include a seam pocket for dowel along back of purse lining. Insert dowel in seam pocket. Dowel adds support for the handle. Tack dowel in place. Place lining in purse and hand stitch around purse's opening. Attach handles or chains to purse base on both sides of flap. If desired, add Pin or Decoration to flap.
