Single Crochet Diagonal Woven Scarf

An elegant scarf crocheted with single crochets and woven with a decorative yarn.

Materials List:

Yarn

2 skeins Red Heart® Anne Geddes Baby™ (80% acrylic, 20% nylon, 3.5oz [100g], 340yd [310m]), Light/3, in color #771 Coral (A)

1 skein Lion Brand® Tweed Stripes® (100% acrylic, 3oz [85g], 144yd [132m]), Bulky/5, in color #209 Prism (B)

Hooks & Notions US H-8 (5mm)

Gauge

5 sc = 1" (2.5 cm)

Finished Measurement

71" x 6.5"

(177.5cm x 16.25cm) (Excluding Fringe)



With A, chain 377 loosely because first row is worked through the back loop. (The pattern is worked in multiples of 6 + 5. If you wish to make the scarf longer or shorter add or delete 6 chains.)

Row 1: Working in back loop only, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across. (376 sc)

Note: By working in the back loop, a 2-loop chain edge is left on the opposite side. This will match the completed edge along the other side of the scarf. No extra edging is needed. Be careful not to twist the base chain while working.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn. *(Sc in next sc) 4 times, ch 2, sk 2 sc; repeat * across ending with (sc in next sc) 4 times.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each sc, 2 sc in each eyelet space, continue across row.

Rows 4 & 5: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each sc across row.

Row 6: Ch 1, turn. Sc in first sc, *ch 2, sk 2 sc, (sc in next sc) 4 times; repeat * across ending with sc in last sc.

Row 7: Repeat Row 3.

Rows 8 & 9: Repeat Rows 4 & 5.

Repeat Rows 2 - 9 until 6.5" (16.25cm) or desired width, end with Row 3 or Row 7. Fasten off A, leaving long tail to be included in tassel.

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Diagonal Woven Design

With B, take desired number of decorative yarn strands or various mixture of yarn strands to comfortably fit in eyelet space. Weave rows in following pattern:

Rows 1 & 2: Weave strands under beginning sc to first eyelet and over from eyelet to eyelet, repeat across.

Rows 3 & 4: Weave strands over beginning sc to first eyelet and under sc to next eyelet, repeat across.

Repeat Rows 1 – 4 until weaving is complete.

Tassel/Fringe

With B, add strands of yarn by loosely wrapping yarn around a DVD case or cardboard that is 8" (20cm) long. Cut along the bottom. Pick up six strands (or desired number) of decorative yarn or various mixture of yarns, loop them in half through first row on each scarf end, pull loop with hook from front to back, loop over all strands and tighten into a knot. After complete, slightly tug on each strand to tighten the knot. When finished, trim bottom of fringe to even it along edge.
