## **Shell Lace Scarf**

Materials List:

Yarn

1 skein Caron® Simply Soft (100% acrylic, 6oz [170g], 315yd [288m]) 4/Medium, Victorian Rose

Hooks & Notions Gauge Measurements

3 shells = 4" (10cm) 6" x 50" US H-8 (5mm) (15cm x 125cm)

Tapestry Needle

V-st: (dc, ch 2, dc) in same stitch.

Shell: 7 dc in V-st space.

Ch 219

NOTE: Patterns requires 6 + 3, to increase or decrease add or subtract 6 ch in foundation ch.

Row 1: Working in blo, dc in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook, dc in each ch across. Turn.

Row 2: Ch 5, dc in base of 1st dc (creates V-st), \*ch 2, sk 5 dc, V-st in next dc; repeat \* across, ending with V-st in top of last dc. Turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, 3 dc in 1st V-st space, \*sk ch-2 sp, Shell in next V-st space; repeat \* across, ending with 3 dc in last V-st space, dc in top of ch-3. Turn.

Row 4: Ch 5, dc in base of 1st dc (creates V-st), \*ch 2, V-st in top of 4th dc of Shell; repeat \* across, ending with V-st in top of 1<sup>st</sup> ch 3. Turn

Repeat Rows 3 – 4 until measures 5" (12.5cm) or desired width.

Finishing Row: Ch 3 (counts as 1st dc), dc in each ch of ch 2 and top of each dc across row. Fasten off and weave in ends.
