Slip Stitch Scarf

Materials List:

Yarn:

1 skein Sensational Rainbow Classic (100% Acrylic, 11oz [312g], 615yd [m]) in color 502 Pink Solid (Actually used – 5oz)

Hook: US K/6mm

Gauge: 6 stitches = 1" (2.5 cm)

Finished Measurements: 53 x 3 ½ " (134.5cm x 9cm)

Ch 251 [measures 53" (134.5cm), add or subtract chain stitches to adjust the scarf for your desired length].

Row 1: Slip Stitch (sl st) in 2nd ch from hook, *sl st in next ch; repeat from * across. Ch 1 and turn.

Row 2: Working in front loop only, sl st in each sl st of previous row. Ch 1 and turn.

Rows 3 - 13: Repeat Row 2.

Row 14: Repeat Row 2, but do not ch 1 and turn. End off yarn and weave in ends.

Optional: Add tassels.
