Spike Stitch Striped Scarf

Materials List:

Yarn

Berroco® Vintage® (52% acrylic, 40% wool, 8% nylon, 3.5oz/100g,

218yd/200mm) 4/Medium

1 skein each of

#5147 Coriander (A)

#5100 Snowy Day (B)

#5167 Dewberry (C)

Hooks & Notions Gauge Measurements

6" x 60"

4 dc = 1" (2.5cm) US H-8 (5mm)

(18cm x 1cm)

Tapestry Needle (excluding fringe)



Spike Stitch: Insert hook into bottom of dc space 1 row down from current row, yo and pull loop up to current row, yo and pull through 2 loops on hook. Open loop to form a V.

Note: Leave 6" at beginning and ending of new yarn to incorporate into fringe.

Ch 246

NOTE: Patterns requires 2, to increase or decrease measurement add or subtract 2 ch in foundation ch.

Row 1 (RS): With A & working in blo, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across. Turn.

Row 2: Ch 3 (1st dc), dc in each sc across. Turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, dc in each dc across. End off A.

Row 4 (RS): Join new color with sc in 1st dc, *Spike in next dc, sc in next dc; repeat * across. Turn.

Rows 5 & 6: Ch 3, dc in each st across. End off yarn.

Following color chart of A, B, C, repeat Rows 4 – 6 until measures 6" (18cm) or desired width. On final row don't end off yarn. Turn.

Last Row (WS): Ch 1, sc in flo across row. End off yarn.

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Fringe

Add strands of yarn by loosely wrapping yarn around a DVD case or cardboard that is 8" (20cm) wide. Cut along the bottom. Pick up 10 strands, loop them in half through first row on each end, pull loop with hook from front to back, loop over strands and tighten into knot. After complete, slightly tug on each strand to tighten the knot. When finished, trim bottom of fringe to even it along edge.
