Cheerio Tunisian Scarf

Materials List:

Yarn

2 balls Premier Starbella® Plaid (39% acrylic, 61% polyester, 12yd [11m])
in color 6805 Parliament

Hooks & Notions	Gauge	Finished Measurement
US G-6 (4mm)	Not Important	69" (177cm)
Needle		End of Ruffle to End of
Thread		Ruffle

Work in top edge of yarn only.

Open mesh as you work.

To add new ball:



Insert hook from front to back under top edge of yarn's beginning. In next yarn space, insert hook from back to front to add another loop on hook. In next yarn space, insert hook from front to back, yo, pull this loop through 2 loops on hook. Yarn is on hook and ready to work.

1. Cast-on Row: *In next yarn space, insert hook from front to back, placing loop on hook; repeat from * 5 times. (6 loops on hook)
2. Cast-off Row: *In next yarn space, insert hook from front to back, yo, pull through 2 loops on hook; repeat from * 5 times. (1 loop on hook)

Repeat Steps 1 and 2 until yarn is completely worked. Pull remaining yarn tail through last loop. With needle and thread securely attach the final loop.

Note: When taking a break, made sure to stop after Step 2 and secure loop. If not, the loop will pull out and your work will unravel.
