Afghan Stitch Ruffled Scarf

Materials List:

Yarn

1 skein Bernat Twist & Twirl (100% acrylic, 3.5oz [100g], 33yd [30m])
in color 23730 Circus

Hooks & Notions	Gauge	Finished Measurement
US G-6 (4mm)	1 st = 1" (2.5cm)	69" (177cm)
Needle		End of Ruffle to End of
Thread		Ruffle

Work in top edge of yarn only.

Always leave 1" (2.5cm) between each stitch.

Open mesh as you work.



Insert hook from back to front near top edge of yarn's beginning. Skip 1" (2.5cm) of yarn, insert hook from front to back to add another loop on hook. Skip 1" (2.5cm) of yarn, insert hook, yo, pull this loop through 2 loops on hook. Yarn is on hook and ready to work.

1. [Skip 1" (2.5cm) of yarn, insert hook from back to front, skip 1" (2.5cm) of yarn, insert hook from front to back] twice. Skip 1" (2.5cm) of yarn, insert hook from back to front. (6 loops on hook)
2. [Skip 1" (2.5cm) of yarn, insert hook, yo, pull through 2 loops on hook] 5 times. (1 loop on hook)

Repeat Steps 1 and 2 until yarn is completely worked. With needle and thread securely attach the final loop.

Note: When taking a break, made sure to stop after Step 2 and secure loop. If not, the loop will pull out and your work will unravel.
